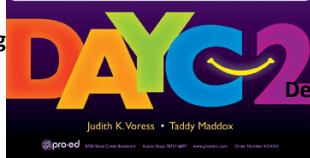

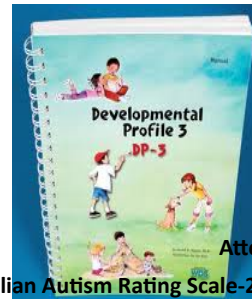


Developmental Assessment for Young Children (DAYC)

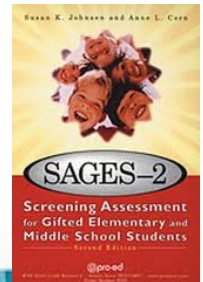
